

GENERAL RULES

- 1) ***NO ALCOHOL ON RIDE.** Anyone found under the influence of alcohol, drugs, etc. will be immediately removed from participation and accompanied back to the place the ride originated. He or she will be required to unsaddle their horse and tie the horse to the trailer.
- 2) No dogs.
- 3) No stallions.
- 4) Each participant must sign a release waiver before they can ride.
- 5) Children 18 and under must have a parent or guardian sign a release waiver.
- 6) Participants may not ride double or without saddles.
- 7) Participants must stay on designated trail.
- 8) No firearms allowed.
- 9) No smoking on the trail.
- 10) No fireworks or noisemakers.
- 11) An adult must accompany children under the age of 15.
- 12) No participants will pass the trail boss.
- 13) Participants will ride in an orderly and safe manner.
- 14) A red ribbon will be attached to the tail of a kicking horse to warn other participants of potential danger.
- 15) Do not litter.
- 16) No loose horses.
- 17) No horses within 60 feet of registration and meal/entertainment area.
- 18) Minimum participant age of 6 years.
- 19) General public will not be allowed to mingle with the horses.

****In rule number one above, if there is any indication that a person is intoxicated, etc., he or she should not be asked to leave the premises, as that allows an intoxicated person on the highway. In Texas, once responsibility is assumed for another person, that individual or organization can be held liable. The intoxicated person should be supervised until a sober, responsible individual accompanies him/her out of the control of the Ride event.***
